- 1. Label each of the 11 free states that existed in 1819 and outline them in blue.
- 2. Label each of the 11 free states that existed in 1819 and outline them in green.
- 3. Label Missouri and outline it in orange.
- 4. Label Maine and outline it in orange.
- 5. Draw the Missouri Compromise line (the line above which the land was free) in orange and label it.
- 6. Label California and outline it in purple.
- 7. Label the territories of New Mexico and Utah and outline them in purple.
- 8. Label the territories of Kansas and Nebraska and outline them in brown.
- 9. Identify the first state to secede from the Union and shade it red.
- 10. Locate and label the capital of the Union (the United States of America) with its name.
- 11. Locate and label the capital of the Confederacy (the Confederate States of America) with its name.*
- 12. Locate and label Fort Sumter.
- 13. Identify the states that joined the Confederacy and give them red stripes.
- 14. Complete the key linking each color to a specific Congressional decision.
