Directions: The second Civil War assessment is a timeline of significant events during the years 1860-1865. Your timeline must include:

- an appropriate title, your name, and your history section
- correctly spaced years and months
- **a total of 20 items** with a **minimum of 5 political/social events**
- the date, location, and a brief summary of the importance of each event
- at least 10 must be **hand** illustrated with a picture or icon that represents the event

You must indicate which events are political/social and which are military events. The following must be included:

### Military Events

- shots fired on Fort Sumter
- Battle of Gettysburg
- Battle of Vicksburg
- Lee surrenders at Appomattox

### Political/Social Events

- Gettysburg Address
- Emancipation Proclamation
- Lincoln's Assassination
- 13th Amendment
